



DISCIPLINE

In keeping with the child's future interest, it is very essential for him/her to imbibe self-discipline. The teacher will take adequate corrective measures to ensure general discipline of the class under him/her. The teachers' efforts will work only with adequate positive inputs from the parents.

- Pupils should respect their teachers and their peers
- Pupils should not disturb or interrupt the class.
- Speaking in English is mandatory in the school premises and in the bus.
- Good manners, good habits, obedience and punctuality are required to be-observed at all times.
- Silence is to be maintained while moving around the premises Pupils are not allowed to leave the school premises during school hours.
- No pupil will be allowed to come out of the classroom without the permission card of the concerned teacher.
- Teachers and students must take special care to preserve an atmosphere of Silence and Serious work during class hours. Running, playing or shouting inside the school building is not allowed. Every teacher in the school premises is responsible for maintaining discipline and decorum amongst the students in the school.
- No student will be permitted to bring razor blades, knives or other lethal objects to school.
- No student may bring into school any objects liable to prove a source of disturbance. eg .- crackers, water pistols, electronic games, ipods, mobile phones etc.

REGULARITY & PUNCTUALITY

- Regular attendance of the pupil is obligatory.
- Attendance on the reopening day is compulsory.
- Pupils shall be in school 5 minutes before the first bell. A student who has been present in the morning will not go home in the course of the school hours except with the prior permission of the Headmistress.
- A student will be allowed to go home provided his / her parents come personally to pick them for any given reason.
- Do not keep your child away from school even for a day unless there is a good reason. Irregularity will impair his progress and hardwork will be minimized.
